GETTING THE MOST FROM YOUR CBCT

Thinking of getting a Cone Beam CT machine for your practice? Not sure if you will make use of it? Scared you might find something unexpected?

“Getting the most from your CBCT” will not only help those who have machines and want to get more from them; but also those who are thinking of making the move from 2D to 3D imaging. Answering some of the questions often raised by those wishing to dip their toes into the world of Cone Beam.

Current legislation in Ireland, states that practitioners using CBCT should have continuing professional development in radiation protection and in the use of their Cone beam. By covering prescriptions, appraisal of datasets and the interpretation of images, this course will help practitioners remain current with these requirements providing 3 hours of verifiable CPD.

The course will be divided into theoretic and practical training. Appropriate prescriptions, the use of selection criteria and guidelines will be covered with lecture based, interactive content.

Appraisal of datasets and interpretation will be addressed using imaging software and a selection of cases that illustrate the versatility of CBCT imaging. Finally, using one of these cases, participants will be guided through writing a radiographic report.
