Speakers' Biographies

Dr. Dympna Daly

Dr. Daly qualified from the University of Dublin, Trinity College; after some time in General Practice she completed her Masters Degree in Paediatric Dentistry in the University of Minnesota. She taught part-time in the Dublin University Dental School for a number of years and is currently in Private Practice limited to Paediatric Dentistry in Galway City. She has a particular interest in the area of Prevention of oral disease in Children

Dr. Maurice Fitzgerald

Dr. Maurice Fitzgerald is a Trinity Graduate in Dental Science, Graduate of the Royal College of Surgeons MFDS and a clinical doctorate in Prosthodontics Trinity College Dublin. He works in Private Referral Practice in Dublin and Teaches undergraduate advanced restorative dentistry in Trinity College Dublin.

Dr. Joe Hennessy

Dr. Hennessy qualified as a dentist from Trinity College Dublin in 2008, obtaining a first Class Honours degree and winning the Sheldon Friel Prize for the overall highest grade in his final exams. He then worked for a year in the Dublin Dental University Hospital as a House Surgeon before moving to work in private practice in Dublin for a further 18 months. He then moved to England where he worked for a year as a Senior House Officer in Maxillofacial Surgery in Chichester, West Sussex. To continue his career development he then worked for 6 months as a Community Dentist in Shewsbury, Shropshire. In 2012, Joe returned to Trinity College

to complete a three-year orthodontic training programme. In 2015, he attained a Clinical Doctorate in Orthodontics from Trinity College and completed his membership exams at the Royal College of Surgeons in Edinburgh and Fellowship Exams at the Royal College of Surgeons in Ireland. Dr. Hennessey is a member of the Orthodontic Society of Ireland and the World Federation of Orthodontists. He is on the Editor Board of the Journal of the Irish Dental Association and the International Journal of Aligner Orthodontics. He is an Orthodontic Supervisor in Dublin Dental University Hospital and a member of the Council of the Irish Dental Association.

Prof. Gerry Kearns

Professor Gerry Kearns is Chair of the Education Committee at the Faculty of Dentistry, RCSI. He is a Consultant Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeon at St James Hospital and Crumlin Childrens Hospital Dublin, also a Past Dean of the Faculty.

Speakers' Biographies

Dr. Orla Killeen

Dr. Orla Killeen graduated from NUIG in 1996. She trained in General Paediatrics in Our Lady's Children's Hospital, Crumlin, and in Temple Street University Hospital, Dublin, before sub-specialising in Paediatric Rheumatology. She undertook her paediatric rheumatology training at Great Ormond Street Children's Hospital, London, and went on to complete a Barbara Ansell Fellowship in Paediatric Rheumatology in the Royal Hospital for Sick Children, Glasgow. She was appointed as Ireland's first Paediatric Rheumatologist in 2004, and has been based at Our Lady's Children's Hospital, Crumlin, and St Vincent's University Hospital, Dublin, since July 2006. She established the National Centre for Paediatric Rheumatology (NCPR) in 2006, providing care for patients with rheumatic and musculoskeletal disorders both on a local and national level.

Dr. Rona Leith

Dr. Rona Leith qualified as a Dental Surgeon from Trinity College Dublin. Following a House Officer year, she worked in private practice for a number of years before pursuing her passion for children's dentistry and completing a Doctorate in Paediatric Dentistry in the Dublin Dental University Hospital and thereafter the FFD from the RCSI. She is past president of the Irish Society of Dentistry for Children and is currently Assistant Professor in Paediatric Dentistry in the Dublin Dental University Hospital.

Dr. Siobhan Lucey

Dr. Lucey graduated from University College Cork (UCC) in 2007 with a First Class Honours BDS degree. She completed specialist training in the Edinburgh Dental Institute and obtained her Membership in Paediatric Dentistry (Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh) in 2013. She also completed a Masters in Clinical Dentistry (Paediatric Dentistry) with the University of Edinburgh. She worked in private practice for several years before being appointed as a Specialist Lecturer in UCC in 2018.

Dr. Brendan O' Hare

Dr O'Hare is a consultant paediatric anaesthetist and intensivist at Crumlin Hospital, Dublin and is also a clinical lecturer in the Dept of Paediatrics in Trinity College Dublin medical school.

Dr. Jennifer Parry

Dr. Jennifer Parry is a Consultant / Senior Lecturer in Paediatric Dentistry at Cork Dental School and Hospital, University College Cork. Dr. Parry graduated from University College Cork and completed a Masters in Paediatric Dentistry from the University of Leeds. After completing Paediatric Dentistry specialty training at the Eastman Dental Institute, and King's and Guy's NHS Hospital Trusts in London, She undertook a Dental Trauma Fellowship at Toronto's Sick kids Hospital. Dr. Parry has worked as a Consultant in Paediatric Dentistry in the UK since 2000, returning to UCC in January 2019.
